



Dilated intrammary duct with some non-specific echoes within it (yellow arrow)





Dilated intrammary duct with some non-specific echoes within it (yellow arrow)




















Diagnosis

- Incidental low grade invasive carcinoma with ductal features, 3 mm.
- Fibrocystic changes with duct ectasia, granulomatous response and dystrophic calcification.
