
58 year old Chinese female, underwent a left mastectomy with sentinel lymph node biopsy after a core biopsy of a left breast lump confirmed invasive cancer.


Section from tumour in the left mastectomy specimen.


































Metaplastic carcinoma (with chondromyxoid elements)







Metaplastic Carcinoma with Mesenchymal Differentiation

- In this category of metaplastic carcinoma, malignant osteoid, chondroid, and chondromyxoid elements are present.
- Liposarcoma is an uncommon heterologous component in metaplastic carcinoma, being more commonly observed in malignant phyllodes tumours.
