Right breast lump at the 1 o'clock peri-areolar region was excised one year ago, reported as haemangioma.


Current presentation with light bruising of the skin over the same area.



Diagnosis

Right breast lump ~

Low grade angiosarcoma







Angiosarcoma

- Permeative anastomosing nature of the vessels
- Invasion into breast lobules
- Mild endothelial atypia
- Immunohistochemistry with endothelial markers accentuate the permeative pattern







Angiosarcoma ~ differential diagnoses

- Haemangioma
- Angiolipoma
- Pseudoangiomatous stromal hyperplasia
- Lymphangioma
- Atypical vascular lesion
- Angiomatosis
- Kaposi sarcoma
- Metaplastic carcinoma with pseudoangiomatoid features
