Carcinomas in Fibroepithelial Lesions of the Breast

- Infrequent
 - -<1% of fibroadenomas</p>
 - 1-2% of phyllodes tumors
 - likely represent overestimates
- LCIS most common (>50% of reported cases affecting fibroadenomas)
- DCIS, invasive carcinoma of NST, invasive lobular carcinomas
- Special type cancers other than lobular carcinomas extremely uncommon

Carcinomas in Fibroepithelial Lesions of the Breast

- Lesion may be confined to fibroepithelial lesion or also involve surrounding breast tissue (especially LCIS)
- Phyllodes tumors with carcinoma usually benign or borderline

Carcinomas in Fibroepithelial Lesions of the Breast

- A few case reports of metaplastic carcinomas arising in phyllodes tumors (squamous in all but one case)
- 1 report of "squamous carcinoma" arising in a fibroadenoma*
