Clinical impression of a phyllodes tumour vs a giant juvenile fibroadenoma.






























































































Diagnosis, case 32

Borderline phyllodes tumour.















Borderline phyllodes tumour

- Histological features are insufficient for a malignant diagnosis.
- Focally infiltrative borders.
- Moderately increased stromal cellularity.
- Mild to moderate stromal nuclear atypia.
- Frequent mitoses (5 to 9 per 10 hpf).
- Rare stromal overgrowth.
