Specimen Required	20 mL fresh random urine in sterile container
Method	Inductively Coupled Plasma Mass Spectrometry (ICP-MS)
Reference Interval/Value	MOM Biological Threshold Limit Value (BTLV) for Arsenic Urine is 300 μg/L.
Turnaround Time	Mean = 7 days, Range 3 - 11 days
Day(s) Test Set up	Monday - Friday
Remarks	 Instructions Before Collection: Patient is advised to refrain from oral ingestion of seafood for 3 days before sample collection. Patient should avoid taking either gadolinium or iodine containing contrast media for at least 4 days as they can interfere with trace metal tests.
