<b>Method</b>	Enzymatic (Pyruvate to Lactate)
<b>Reference Interval/Value</b>	0 – 12 yrs: 222 - 454 U/L 13 – 17 yrs: 222 - 454 U/L ≥ 18 yrs: 222 - 454 U/L
<b>Turnaround Time</b>	Mean = 4 hrs, Range: 3 – 5 hrs
<b>Day(s) Test Set up</b>	Daily
