Description	Nipah Virus IgM Antibody (anti-Nipah IgM)  Nipah Virus IgG Antibody (anti-Nipah IgG)
Specimen Required	<ul><li>3 - 5 mL plain blood for anti-Nipah IgM and anti- Nipah IgG or 1 mL CSF for anti-Nipah IgM.</li><li>(a) To diagnose acute infection, send blood for IgM and IgG two weeks apart or CSF for IgM two weeks apart.</li><li>(b) To diagnose past infection, send a single blood sample for IgG.</li></ul>
Storage and Transport	Refrigerate samples if delay in transporting to laboratory is anticipated. <b>Do not freeze.</b>
Method	Enzyme Immunoassay
Test Result	Acute infection: Presence of Nipah IgM antibody or paired samples showing seroconversion.
Turnaround Time	2 - 30 days
Day(s) Test Set up	Once per month
