Specimen Required	Bronchoalveolar lavage or washings are preferred specimens. Bronchial brushings or sputum may be submitted, but the diagnostic yield is less. Send fresh specimens (see General Instruction (/clinical-departments-centers/pathology/pathology-handbook/lab-discipline-special-instructions/pages/cytology.aspx#NGYN)). Fix submitted smears with cytology spray fixative or immerse in 95% ethanol for 20 minutes. Write "Evaluate for <i>Pneumocystis Carinii</i> or <i>Pneumocystis Jiroveci Pneumonia</i> on the request form (/clinical-departments-centers/pathology/pathology-handbook/lab-discipline-special-instructions/pages/cytology.aspx#NGYTRF).
