Indications	VDRL is a screening test for treponemal infection. Weakly Reactive and Reactive values should be confirmed by LIA TP Confirmation test or TPPA.
Specimen Required	3 mL plain blood
Method	Micro flocculation
Test Result	The test is reported as Non-reactive, Weakly Reactive or Reactive. Reactive values are given with dilution factor in brackets.
Turnaround Time	Range 1 – 3 days
