Continuing Professional Development Lecture: Can Rehabilitation Increase Strength and Motor Recovery Following Spinal Cord Injury? 7 May 2019

Synopsis

Neurologically-induced weakness is common following incomplete spinal cord injuries. Numerous interventions are administered by therapists in an effort to decrease this weakness and promote motor recovery. In this presentation I will discuss the results of our own recent clinical trials and systematic reviews on this topic in the light of the work of others, and explain how our findings challenge some long held assumptions.

Speaker



Professor Lisa Harvey (PhD) has 20 years clinical experience in spinal cord injuries. She currently holds an academic position at Sydney Medical School, University of Sydney where she teaches, runs her own research program and supervises PhD students.

She had been responsible for the spinal cord injury teaching provided to undergraduate and postgraduate physiotherapy students at the University of Sydney for the last 20 plus years. In addition, she authored one of the leading text books on physiotherapy management of people with spinal cord injuries (Management of spinal cord injuries: A guide for physiotherapists, Elsevier). She has over 150 publications which include clinical trials and systematic reviews. Most of her research has focused on putting an evidence base to widely administered physiotherapy interventions for people with spinal cord injuries and other neurological conditions. She is Editor-in-Chief of Spinal Cord and on the editorial board of the Journal of Physiotherapy.
