

Medical Nutrition Therapy for Weight Management (Medical and Surgical) 7 January 2020

Introduction

This 1 day course will allow Dietitians to have a better understanding of the role of the Dietitian as an essential member of the Multidisciplinary Weight Management care team. They will learn how to interpret and translate latest nutrition recommendations and guidelines into daily practice.

Knowledge and skills acquired from the course will benefit participants by improving their patient assessment skills and empower them with the skills to employ appropriate dietary strategies for patients requiring weight loss, in both medical and surgical intervention.

Course Objectives

- Equip Dietitians with essential nutrition knowledge on weight strategies.
- Update Dietitians on the evidence-based approach to the use of effective assessment tools and provision of nutrition intervention in medical weight management.
- Equip Dietitians with knowledge of the latest and current principles and nutrition recommendations for pre- and post-bariatric surgery.
- Equip Dietitians with evidence-based approach in behavioural modification for successful weight loss.

Course Outline

- Describe the aetiology of overweight and obesity and its impact on health
- Medical Nutrition Therapy for obesity, which includes:
 - Evidence based assessment tools
 - The use of meal replacements
 - Consideration of the use of pharmacotherapy and its' side effects
- Medical Nutrition Therapy for bariatric management, which includes:
 - Types of bariatric surgery and the impact on nutrition
 - Short and long term complications
 - The need for specific nutritional supplementation following bariatric surgery
 - The progression of diet and meal planning through the various stages of pre- and post- bariatric surgery
- Importance of and application of Motivational interviewing in nutritional management of obesity
