In 2017, she achieved her doctoral degree in Business Administration (DBA) from University of Liverpool, UK. She is also an alumnus of Kellogg School of Management, USA.

Dr Ang's current administrative and leadership role in the hospital includes the oversight of professional groups such as the pharmacists, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, podiatrists, dieticians, psychologists, medical social workers and music therapists.

In the area of education, Dr Ang teaches leadership courses and conducts mentorship workshops. She is also Program Director and Instructor of the SPC-endorsed Pharmacy Preceptor Training course. She presently sits on the Advisory Board of SGH-Postgraduate Allied Health Institute.

Dr Ang is strongly committed towards developing talents and future leaders. She has mentored many pharmacists and allied health professionals and continues to do so.
