



Comprehensive care for older patients in the hospital, is it possible?

Introduction

Hospitalisations can lead to acquisition or worsening of the geriatric syndromes. Geriatric syndromes consist of cognitive issues such as delirium, dementia, depression, incontinence, falls, malnutrition with weight loss or functional decline. Each hospital stay often causes the elderly to be in a worse state compared to when they were first admitted. This will cause a vicious cycle of re-admissions, further weight loss, functional decline, frailty and caregiver burden and eventually leads to increased cost, disabilities, caregiver burnout and institutionalisation.

Course Objectives

This course aims to enable participants to:

- Identify risks of complications associated with hospitalisation early
- Identify patients at high risk for falls, incontinence, delirium or poor nutrition
- Put in place early assessment and propose interventions before complications set in
- Understand and explain long term consequences which elderly patients may develop that affect their independence and impact on caregivers

She has also developed a system to prevent abscondment of patients with cognitive issues in CGH for patients' safety.
