Introduction

Occupational Therapists often see patients with arthritis as well as Repetitive Strain Injuries (RSI) which can affect them in many different ways. They may find simple movements difficult and painful and encounter difficulties in managing their day-to-day activities. Occupational therapy helps to empower patients to live life to its fullest by maximizing their ability to participate in activities (occupations) through activity analysis, use of orthosis and assistive devices and exercise.

Course Objectives

- 1) Understand the etiology of the following conditions:
 - Osteoarthritis
 - Rheumatoid Arthritis
 - Repetitive Stress Injuries (e.g. Carpal Tunnel Syndrome, Trigger Finger, DeQuervain's Tenosynovitis, Elbow Tendonitis)
- 2) Propose or apply evidence-based intervention strategies to manage the abovementioned conditions
