


64 year old Chinese lady presented with a right breast lump at the 6 o'clock position. An ultrasound guided trucut biopsy was performed.


This was followed by surgical excision a week later.


The excised specimen contained a reddish brown nodule 1.4 cm in maximum dimension.




 Trucut biopsy: Vasoformative lesion, suggestive of a haemangioma.


Excision biopsy














Diagnosis

• Cellular angiolipoma.

Cellular angiolipoma

- Can mimic angiosarcoma.
- Clues to benign nature:
 - Good circumscription.
 - Lack of significant endothelial cytologic atypia.
 - Mitotically inert.
 - Absence of anastomosing vascular channels.
 - Absence of necrosis.
