















































Diagnosis

- Right breast excision:
 - Ductal carcinoma in situ, high nuclear grade with necrosis and cystic changes.
 - ER negative, PR negative.
 - Small component of low nuclear grade DCIS.





Classification of DCIS

- Nuclear grade ~
 - Low, intermediate, high
- Based on highest grade present.
- Although infrequent, low and high grade DCIS can coexist in the same breast, and sometimes even in the same duct.
