Left breast 12 o'clock 17 x 11 x 20mm.


Right breast 2 o'clock 5 x 3 x 9mm.

Ultrasound guided core biopsies of both nodules.













Section from left breast (A).





















Section from right breast (B).























Myofibroblastomas









Myofibroblastoma

- Rare benign spindle stromal neoplasm arising from the connective tissue of the breast.
- Middle aged to elderly men and women.
- Clinically presents as a unilateral mobile painless lump.
- Bilaterality can occur though uncommon.
- Treatment of choice in symptomatic cases is resection.
- No recurrence has been reported after excision.
- Asymptomatic small tumours can be observed for stability.
