Description	The test is used for detecting total antibodies against <i>Aspergillus fumigatus</i> , <i>A. flavus</i> , <i>A. niger</i> and <i>A. terreus</i>
Indications	To diagnose aspergilloma, allergic bronchopulmonary aspergillosis (ABPA) and hypersensitivity pneumonitis in immunocompetent hosts
Specimen Required	3 mL plain blood
Method	Immunodiffusion
Test Result	Reported as Positive or Negative for <i>Aspergillus</i> Antibody
Turnaround Time	Range 2 – 12 days
Day(s) Test Set up	Batch tested, once/week
