



## THEOPHYLLINE, SERUM

<b>Specimen Required</b>	3 mL plain blood  For the peak level, draw blood 2h after administration of drug with rapid release properties, or 4h after administration of drug with sustained release properties.  For trough level, draw sample just before the next dose.
<b>Method</b>	Immunoassay
<b>Reference Interval/Value</b>	Therapeutic Range : From 0 day : 8 - 20 mg/L
<b>Turnaround Time</b>	Mean = 4 hrs, Range: 3 - 5 hrs
<b>Day(s) Test Set up</b>	Daily

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
