Specimen Required	Submit specimen in a clean container within one hour of collection. Indicate on the request form "Voided" or "Catheterised" as appropriate. If more than one site is sampled, the source of the specimen must be indicated on each specimen container - see Non-Gynaecological smear, fluid and Fine Needle Aspiration (FNA) – General Instruction (/clinical-departments-centers/pathology/pathology-handbook/lab-discipline-special-instructions/pages/cytology.aspx#NGYN)for details.
