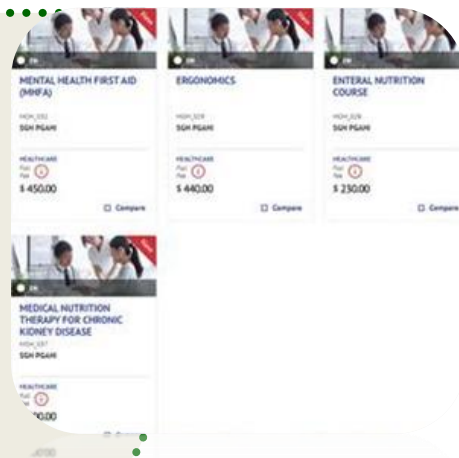


## Skills Future Credit for PGAHI courses
