Continuing Professional Development Lecture: Vestibulopathy: A Common Diagnosis But What Does It Really Mean? 13 July 2020

Synopsis

A common clinical mistake is to send patients diagnosed with vestibulopathy, with no functional impairment for Vestibular Rehabilitation Therapy (VRT). These patients do not benefit from it as there is nothing for therapists to correct. A diagnosis alone with a symptom checklist and objective test findings are insufficient to determine a functional impairment. Functional impairment is a consequence that ensues as a result of the symptoms, such as a major limitation in activities of daily living, relative to most people.

During this talk, participants will be introduced to:

1. Considerations when making management decisions based solely on objective test results.
2. Procedural and conceptual knowledge in order to plan the most efficacious diagnosed-based rehabilitation strategies.

Kenneth has been with Changi General Hospital (CGH) since 2015 as an Audiologist, and works in the areas of adult hearing and balance diagnostics and rehabilitation. As a vestibular audiologist, he will be working closely with a multi-disciplinary team of physicians and physiotherapists to diagnose and treat vestibular patients.
