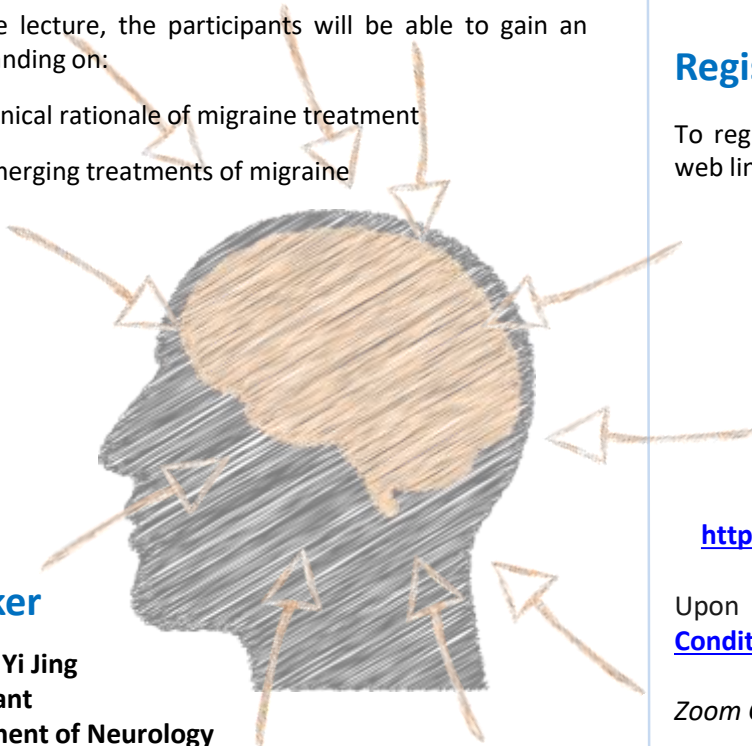
Synopsis
