He received his specialist accreditation in Neurology in 2014. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (Edinburgh) since 2015.

Apart from seeing patients with a variety of Neurological conditions, Dr Ong's main interest lies in Headache Disorders and Facial pain. He was awarded the Academic Medicine Development award 2016/2017, and pursued his passion in Headache Neurology at King's College Hospital, London, under the tutelage of Professor Peter J Goadsby.
