

Ultrasound Elastography Course 23 October 2021

Introduction

Ultrasound elastography is a relatively new, clinically validated imaging technique. Clinical applications of elastography include breast and prostate lesions characterization, fibrosis staging and musculoskeletal.

This half-day course will provide participants with the core principles of strain and shear-wave elastography, and the required knowledge and skills in the use of elastography in liver, musculoskeletal and breast imaging.

Course Objectives

After completing this course, the participant should be able to:

1. Describe the principles of strain and shear-wave elastography

2. Differentiate between strain and shear-wave elastography

3. Discuss the clinical application of strain and shearwave elastography in the evaluation of liver fibrosis & cirrhosis, musculo-tendinous pathologies and breast lesions

4. Recognise the normal and abnormal features of liver, musculo-tendinous and breast tissues evaluated using ultrasound elastography
