



The Missing Link: Appreciate Radiographic Projections through Image Interpretation

7 – 8 October 2021

Introduction

Radiographic image interpretation is a core skill that a radiographer should be equipped with to value-add in radiography imaging practice. This two half day course adopts a team-based learning method via Zoom, and allows participants to acquire knowledge of image interpretation of the upper and lower extremities.

Course Objectives

At the end of the course, the participants will be able to:

- Identify and describe acute abnormality in the upper and lower extremities.
- Recognise normal variants that mimic acute abnormalities in the upper and lower extremities.
- Apply image interpretation knowledge to upper and lower extremities during radiographic positioning.

Course Outline

- Upper Extremity: image interpretation, common pitfalls and normal variants.
- Lower Extremity: image interpretation, common pitfalls and normal variants.
- Radiographic projection modifications to demonstrate upper and lower extremities abnormalities.
- Additional radiographic projections: technique, criteria and decision making.

Target Audience

Diagnostic radiographers who have an interest in radiography image interpretation and with at least 3 years experience in general radiography.
