# Influencing Behaviour in Dementia Care Through Person-centred Approach (Part 2)

## 3 – 5 February & 4 March 2021

### Introduction

This course is an extension of Influencing Behaviour in Dementia Care Through Person-centred Approach course (Part 1). In this advanced course, participants will focus on applying knowledge gained earlier by preparing a case study of an existing patient and an Enriched Model of Dementia Care Plan. The presentation and discussion session will enable participants to deepen their understanding of the theoretical frameworks and further improve their care plan.

### Course Objectives

- 1) Adopt the Person-centred approach (PCA) to relate to practical care issues
- 2) Apply skills and techniques based on the Enriched Model of Dementia to influence responsive behaviours of persons with dementia.
- 3) Apply Person-centred Approach to collaborate with caregivers to address responsive behaviours of persons with dementia

  - b) Validation
- 3) Person-centred Approach Interventions to collaborate with caregivers
