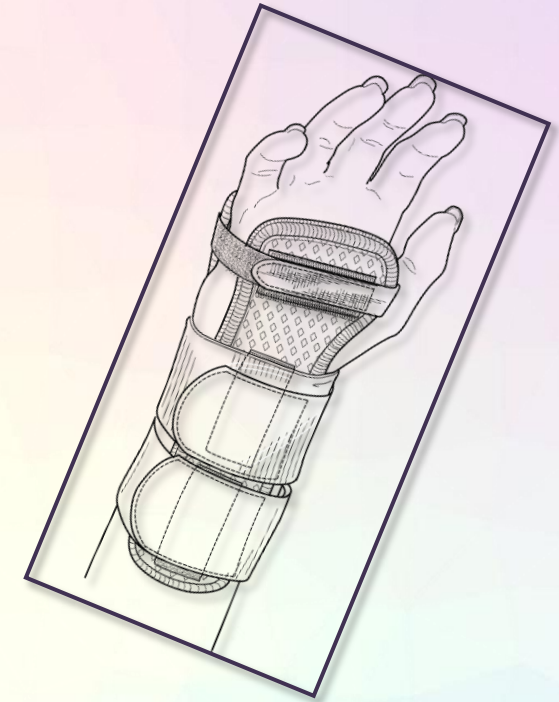

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COURSE OBJECTIVES

The course aims to equip occupational therapists with the relevant knowledge and skills to manage common rheumatological conditions seen at work. It aims to deepen participants' understanding of the etiology of conditions such as osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis and repetitive stress injuries like trigger finger and dequervain's tenosynovitis and provide evidence-based intervention strategies for these conditions.

Participants will be introduced to splints and supports commonly used to treat and manage these rheumatology conditions. As part of the course, participants will have the opportunity to practice fabricating common splints used in rheumatology, for example the resting hand splint, finger trough and thumb splints.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1 - Theory

1. Understanding Osteoarthritis (OA) and rheumatoid arthritis (RA)
2. Understanding repetitive stress injuries: trigger finger, dequervain's, carpal tunnel syndrome, golfer's/tennis elbow

Day 2 - Splints and Supports

1. Splints and supports for OA and RA
 - fabricate finger trough/ OA mallet
 - resting hand splint
2. splints and supports for Repetitive Stress Injuries
 - fabricate long thumb spica

FACULTY

Ms Julia Chong is a Senior Occupational Therapist from Singapore General Hospital with special interest in the area of geriatric rehabilitation and internal medicine. Certified in administering of the AMPs, she has also had experience working in the areas of orthopedics, outpatient and rheumatology attending to patients with osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis as well as repetitive strain injuries.

Ms Lin Yingying is a Senior Occupational Therapist, from Singapore General Hospital specialising in the area of rheumatology. She has 5 years experience working with patients with arthritic conditions and repetitive stress injuries. In 2010, Yingying received the HMDP training award for a 2 month attachment in the UK in rheumatology. On returning, she helped to start up the Occupational Therapy rheumatology service in the Autoimmunity and Rheumatology Centre (ARC) in SGH.
