- Understand the importance of thoracic spine function on cervical spine disorders
- Provide effective management strategies based on a clinical reasoning framework
- Formulate a treatment plan and exercise programme that will address relevant impairments and maximise recovery and function
- Appreciate the principles spinal surgery and imaging and their implications on physiotherapy management
