Pharmacy Preceptor Training

Introduction

The course frames the partnership journey of the preceptor and the trainee in the developmental experience for the learner; from **preparation, onboarding** into real world practice and the **lived experience** of precepting and nurturing the trainee into a full-fledged pharmacist.

Course Objectives

This course aims to help participants to:

- Understand the goals of preceptorship, the roles and responsibilities and expectations of a preceptor
- Understand self-leadership in order to effectively lead others
- Discuss the importance of ethical practice, professionalism, interpersonal and communication skills
- Learn and practice how to precept and coach (include learning styles, teaching approaches, questioning, clinical reasoning)
- Learn and practice how to give feedback objectively and effectively
- Learn and practice how to do assessment in the developmental continuum
- Discuss the importance of motivational skills including handling of Generation Z
- Learn the changes involved transiting to the new assessment methodology
- Discuss the challenges of precepting and how to overcome them
- Discuss the key success factors for the preceptor in achieving optimal training for the trainee
